9 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
10 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS FOR  
11 THE PURCHASE OF NATURAL GAS, AFTER PUBLICLY  
12 ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

15 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of  
16 Ohio, that:

17  
18 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or  
19 contracts, for the purchase of natural gas for a period of time not to exceed five years.  
20

21 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same  
22 from funds properly appropriated to the various departments of the City for these purposes,  
23 according to an apportionment of costs as between the departments.  
24

25 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
26 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent  
27 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

29 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
30 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that  
31 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were  
32 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable,  
33 including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.  
34

35 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
36 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
37 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to purchase natural  
38 gas at the best possible price, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the  
39 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
40 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period  
41 allowed by law.
