Temp. Ord. A-87

An ordinance amending the Traffic Control File by providing for installation of various traffic control devices, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Tony Demasi, City Engineer, presented Temporary Ordinance A-87 to Council. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control File will be hereby amended as follows:

1. Installation of stop sign on North Steels Circle at East Steels Corners Road.
2. Installation of 25 MPH speed limit signs on North Steels Circle Road for the entire development.
3. Installation of stop signs on Redwood Drive at West Bath Road, Aspen Place at Redwood Drive, Poplar Lane at Redwood Drive and Aspen Place at Poplar Lane.
4. Installation of speed limit signs posted designating all roads in the development as 25 MPH, including Redwood Drive, Aspen Place and Poplar Lane.
5. Installation of stop sign on Pine Avenue at State Road.
6. Installation of 25 MPH speed limit signs posted on Pine Avenue for the entire development.

The Chief of Police will be authorized and directed to note in the Traffic Control File the proper legends. The Mayor will be authorized and directed to cause the installation or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.
