An ordinance approving a zoning map amendment for property located at the intersection of Clyde Avenue and Buchholzer Boulevard, from C-1, Commercial to R-5, Mixed Density Residential, and declaring an emergency.

Temp. Ord. A-126

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts with Siemens Energy for the purchase of three 833kVA regulators, and declaring an emergency.

Temp. Ord. A-127

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the Lippman Parkway storm sewer replacement, and declaring an emergency.

Temp. Ord. A-128

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the storm sewer improvements in Preston Park, and declaring an emergency.

An ordinance authorizing the mayor to enter into a contract or contracts with Medical Mutual of Ohio for the City's group life insurance for employees and retirees for a period not to exceed three years, and declaring an emergency.
