**New Ordinances & Resolutions**

**Temp. Ord. A-131**

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Finance to enter into a contract or contracts without competitive bidding with the Metropolitan Regional Service Council dba Northeast Ohio Network for Educational Technology for the purchase of IP telephony and voicemail services for a period not to exceed three years, and declaring an emergency.

**Temp. Ord. A-132**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor, as Director of Public Safety, to enter into a contract or contracts, without competitive bidding, with Axon Enterprises, Inc. for the purchase of the TASER 7 plan for use by the City's safety forces, and declaring an emergency.

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor, as Director of Public Safety, to enter into a contract or contracts with Hasenstab Architects for architectural design services related to the construction of the new Fire Station 4 campus, including a training facility and fire prop, and declaring an emergency.

**Temp. Ord. A-137**

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the installation of a new 12” water main on West Portage Trail from Valley Road to Northampton Road, and declaring an emergency.
