5 ORDINANCE NO. 106 - 2012

7 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE AUTHORIZED
8 STAFFING OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND
9 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

10
11 WHEREAS, Article III, Section 8 of the City Charter authorizes this Council
12 to provide for the authorized staffing of officers and employees in the Fire
13 Department; and

14
15 WHEREAS, the City has retained McGrath Consulting Group, Inc. to
16 conduct a performance assessment of the Fire Department, which assessment
17 will include recommended staffing levels for uniformed personnel; and

18
19 WHEREAS, the final report of the McGrath Consulting Group is not
20 expected before the end of the first quarter, Fiscal Year 2013,

21
22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
23 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

25 Section 1. Subject to the sufficiency of annual or supplemental
26 appropriations for personal services in the Fire Department, the Fire
27 Department shall be composed of the following officers and other personnel:

29 Officers:

- 30 1 Chief
- 31 1 Assistant Chief
- 32 3 Captains
- 33 19 Lieutenants
- 34 49 Firefighters

35
36 Other Personnel:

- 37 1 Office Manager
- 38 1 Secretary I
- 39 1 Regular Part-Time Laborer
- 40 1 Temporary Part-Time Laborer

41
42 Section 2. Not later than ninety (90) days following the City's receipt of the
43 final report of the McGrath Consulting Group, the Director of Public Safety shall
44 propose a staffing ordinance based upon a proposed permanent staffing model.

45
46 Section 3. Ordinance No. 178-2004, passed December 29, 2004, is hereby
47 repealed.

48
49 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances
50 and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances

51 and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
52 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and
53 confirmed.

55 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
56 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an
57 open meeting of this Council and all deliberations of this Council and any of its
58 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the
59 public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the
60 Codified Ordinances.

62 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
63 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience
64 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and
65 provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
66 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
67 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force
68 at the earliest period allowed by law.


