6 ORDINANCE NO. 116 - 2011

8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
9 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,  
10 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE REPLACEMENT OR  
11 ADJUSTMENT OF CONCRETE SIDEWALKS, DRIVE APPROACHES  
12 AND CURBS AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN THE CITY OF  
13 CUYAHOGA FALLS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.  
14

15 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. -2011, a sidewalk and drive approach replacement or  
16 adjustment district was created within the City of Cuyahoga Falls for the purpose of replacing or  
17 adjusting sidewalks, drive approaches and curbs throughout the City;  
18

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of  
20 Summit and State of Ohio, that:

21 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or  
22 contracts, according to law, for replacement or adjustment of concrete sidewalks, drive approaches  
23 and curbs at various locations in the City of Cuyahoga Falls.

26 Section 2. All bids submitted must conform to and be in accordance with the specifications for  
27 the same now on file in the Office of the City Engineer.  
28

29 Section 3. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same  
30 from the Capital Projects Fund.


32 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
33 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or  
34 portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been  
35 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

37 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
38 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that  
39 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were  
40 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including, to the extent  
41 applicable, Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

43 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
44 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
45 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the  
46 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
47 passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest  
48 period allowed by law.
