7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY
8 TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, WITHOUT
9 COMPETITIVE BIDDING, WITH PARAGRID, INC., FOR THE
10 PROFESSIONAL SERVICES, HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE
11 NECESSARY TO UPGRADE THE CITY'S DATA NETWORK SERVERS,
12 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

14 WHEREAS, purchase of the hardware and software provided for under the contract authorized by this
15 Ordinance is exempt from competitive selection procedures, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §125.04(C),
16

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit
18 and State of Ohio, that:

20 Section 1. The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into a contact or contracts,
21 without competitive bidding, with Paragrid, Inc., on the basis of its proposal dated February 3, 2011, for the
22 professional services necessary to upgrade the City's data network servers, including hardware, software,
23 installation, implementation and knowledge transfer.


25 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from
26 the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.


28 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
29 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions
30 of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are
31 hereby ratified and confirmed.
32

33 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
34 to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations
35 of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to
36 the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
37

38 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
39 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and
40 provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it
41 shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall
42 take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
