7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE ANNUAL REQUIREMENTS OF
10 THE MUNICIPAL GARAGE FOR 2011, AND DECLARING AN
11 EMERGENCY.

13 WHEREAS, it is necessary to purchase materials, supplies and equipment for use by the
14 municipal garage on an annual basis;

15
16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
17 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

19 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
20 contracts, according to law, for the purchase of certain materials, supplies, equipment and
21 services for use by the Garage Department during 2011:

23 Fuel
24 Tires
25 Repairs


28 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for
29 same from the Garage Fund, line item Other Operations.



31 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
32 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions
33 or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not
34 previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

36 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
37 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
38 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
39 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
40 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.



42 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
43 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
44 Falls and the inhabitants thereof for the reason that the supplies are necessary for the daily
45 functioning of the Municipal Garage, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of
46 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon
47 its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
48 period allowed by law.
