7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF  
8 PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR  
9 CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE  
10 PURCHASE OF ANNUAL REQUIREMENTS OF  
11 CERTAIN MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES FOR USE BY  
12 THE STREETS DIVISION DURING 2012, AND  
13 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.  
14

15 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of  
16 Summit and State of Ohio, that:

17  
18 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a  
19 contract or contracts, according to law, for the purchase of the following  
20 materials and supplies for use by the Streets Division during 2012:

22 Rock Salt  
23 Rock Salt Conveying  
24 Asphaltic Products  
25 Sign Materials  
26 Paint Supplies

28 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make  
29 payment for same from the SCMR Fund, line item Other Operations, State  
30 Highway Improvement Fund, line item Other Operations, Capital Projects Fund,  
31 line item Capital Outlay, and Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund, line item Other  
32 Operations.  
33

34 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances  
35 and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances  
36 and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent  
37 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and  
38 confirmed.

40 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
41 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an  
42 open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of  
43 any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open  
44 to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107  
45 of the Codified Ordinances.

47 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure  
48 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience  
49 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and  
50 provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or

1 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
2 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force  
3 at the earliest period allowed by law.
