5 ORDINANCE NO. 22 - 2012

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,  
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE REPLACEMENT OR REPAIR OF  
10 CONCRETE SIDEWALKS, DRIVE APPROACHES AND CURBS AT  
11 VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS, AND  
12 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.  
13

14 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. \_\_-2012, a sidewalk and drive approach repair or  
15 replacement assessment district was created within the City of Cuyahoga Falls for the purpose of  
16 replacing or repairing sidewalks and drive approaches throughout the City,  
17

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of  
19 Summit and State of Ohio, that:  
20

21 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or  
22 contracts, according to law, for replacement or repair of concrete sidewalks, drive approaches and  
23 curbs at various locations in the City of Cuyahoga Falls.  
24

25 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same  
26 from the Capital Projects Fund.  
27

28 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
29 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of  
30 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed  
31 are hereby ratified and confirmed.  
32

33 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
34 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that  
35 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were  
36 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including, to the extent  
37 applicable, Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

39 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
40 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
41 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the  
42 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
43 passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest  
44 period allowed by law.
