7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SAFETY TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
9 WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING, WITH INNOPRISE SOFTWARE,
10 INC., FOR THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES NECESSARY TO
11 INSTALL, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE AN ENTERPRISE SOFTWARE
12 SYSTEM, INCLUDING ASSOCIATED SOFTWARE LICENSING, AND
13 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

15 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of
16 Ohio, that:

18 Section 1. The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into a contact or
19 contracts, without competitive bidding, with Innoprise, Software, Inc., on the basis of its proposal
20 dated February 24, 2011, for the professional services necessary to install, maintain and operate a
21 full enterprise software system, including implementation, data conversion, training, upgrades,
22 modifications, and technical support, as well as software licensing.


24 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for lump
25 sum implementation and software licensing fees from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital
26 Outlay, and for maintenance fees from funds properly appropriated therefor.

28 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
29 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of
30 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed
31 are hereby ratified and confirmed.


33 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
34 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that
35 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were
36 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of
37 the Codified Ordinances.

39 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
40 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
41 Falls, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed
42 to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the
43 Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
