7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER
8 INTO A MODIFICATION OF CONTRACT NO. 6712 WITH
9 SUPERIOR ENVIRONMENTAL CORPORATION, AND
10 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

12 WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of Ordinance No. 90-2011, the City entered
13 into Contract No. 6712 with Superior Environmental Corp. for the for the professional
14 services necessary to conduct a Phase II Environmental Assessment and ancillary
15 environmental services in connection with certain real property (Parcels ##02-18449,
16 02-19506 and 02-18447), as necessary for preparation and submission of a grant
17 application to the Clean Ohio Revitalization Fund; and

19 WHEREAS, it is necessary to adjust the scope of work beyond what was originally
20 estimated, including additional project management, field services, supplies,
21 equipment, drilling, laboratory testing and disposal, due to unforeseen site conditions,
22 in order to complete the work, which changes will increase the estimated total contract
23 price by an amount not exceeding \$29,773.62,

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
26 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

28 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a modification of Contract
29 No. 6712 with Superior Environmental Corporation, increasing the scope of work to
30 include additional project management, field services, supplies, equipment, drilling,
31 laboratory testing and disposal, in an amount not exceeding \$29,773.62 over the
32 original estimated contract price. Said modification shall be prepared in writing and
33 signed by the Mayor on behalf of the City.

35 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to pay invoices
36 for work based upon the Contract as modified, from the CDBG Fund, Line Item Other
37 Operations.

39 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
40 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
41 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and
42 which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

44 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
45 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
46 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
47 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in
48 compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified
49 Ordinances.

50
51 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
52 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
53 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided, it receives the
54 affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall

1 take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor;
2 otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
