7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARK AND RECREATION
8 BOARD TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITHOUT COMPETITIVE
9 BIDDING WITH LANDSCAPE STRUCTURES, INC. FOR THE
10 PURCHASE OF PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT FOR INSTALLATION
11 AT QUIRK CULTURAL CENTER, AND DECLARING AN
12 EMERGENCY.

14 WHEREAS, the purchase by contract of the equipment, services, materials or supplies
15 identified herein is through participation in a contract between the vendor and the State of Ohio,
16 Dept. of Administrative Services, and is thus exempt from competitive bidding requirements
17 pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §125.04,

18
19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
20 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

22 Section 1. The Park and Recreation Board is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
23 without competitive bidding with Landscape Structures, Inc. a Minnesota corporation authorized
24 to do business in Ohio, for the purchase of playground equipment for installation at Quirk
25 Cultural Center playground.

27 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for
28 same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

29
30 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
31 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of
32 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
33 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

34
35 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
36 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
37 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
38 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
39 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

41 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
42 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
43 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
44 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
45 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
46 period allowed by law.
