7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITHOUT
9 COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH GENUINE PARTS COMPANY FOR
10 THE PURCHASE OF A PREFABRICATED, UNASSEMBLED
11 METAL STORAGE BUILDING, AND DECLARING AN EMER-
12 GENCY.

14 WHEREAS, Section 2 of the City Charter, adopted pursuant to Art. XVIII, Sections 3 and 7 of
15 the Ohio Constitution, authorizes this Council to make exception to the competitive bidding pro-
16 cedures set forth in the Revised Code,

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
19 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

20
21 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with-
22 out competitive bidding with the Genuine Parts Company, a Georgia corporation licensed to do
23 business in Ohio, for the purchase of a prefabricated, unassembled metal storage building of ap-
24 proximately 15,000 square feet when assembled.

25
26 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for
27 same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

28
29 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
30 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordi-
31 nances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed
32 are hereby ratified and confirmed.

33
34 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
35 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
36 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
37 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
38 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

40 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
41 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
42 Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
43 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
44 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
45 period allowed by law.
