8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE  
9 TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS WITHOUT  
10 COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH SUNGARD PUBLIC SECTOR,  
11 INC. FOR SOFTWARE MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT OF  
12 EGOVERNMENT SOFTWARE APPLICATIONS, AND DECLARING  
13 AN EMERGENCY.  
14

15 WHEREAS, SunGard Public Sector, Inc. is the sole source purveyor of software maintenance  
16 and support services for Naviline and associated eGovernment software applications licensed by  
17 the City,  
18

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County  
20 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:  
21

22 Section 1. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts  
23 without competitive bidding with SunGard Public Sector, Inc., on the basis of its proposal dated  
24 December 16, 2010, for software maintenance and support of Naviline and other eGovernment  
25 software applications licensed from SunGard.  
26

27 Section 2. The Director of Finance is further authorized and directed to make payment for  
28 same from funds properly appropriated therefor, as listed on Exhibit A attached.


30 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
31 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions  
32 or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not  
33 previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.  
34

35 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
36 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and  
37 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal  
38 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including  
39 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.  
40

41 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
42 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
43 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
44 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
45 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest  
46 period allowed by law.
