6 ORDINANCE NO. 53 - 2012

8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
9 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,  
10 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF  
11 CONCRETE PAVEMENT AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN THE CITY,  
12 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13  
14 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of  
15 Ohio, that:

16  
17 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or  
18 contracts, according to law, for the reconstruction of concrete pavement within the public right-of-  
19 way at the following locations:

- 20  
21 a) Remington Road  
22 b) Cavalier Trail  
23

24 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same  
25 from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

27 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
28 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent  
29 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

30  
31 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
32 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that  
33 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were  
34 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable,  
35 including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

36  
37 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
38 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
39 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to permit timely and  
40 appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of  
41 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
42 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period  
43 allowed by law.
