7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ISSUE AN ENCROACHMENT PERMIT TO
9 BARBARA S. DIETERICH DBA DIAMOND DELI FOR THE
10 PURPOSE OF INSTALLING AND MAINTAINING OUTDOOR
11 SEATING AND FOOD SERVICE ACTIVITIES IN THE PUBLIC
12 RIGHT-OF-WAY OF FRONT STREET, AND DECLARING AN
13 EMERGENCY.

15 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and
16 State of Ohio, that:

18 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to issue an encroachment
19 permit, revocable at the will of Council, to Barbara S. Dieterich dba Diamond Deli, for the
20 purpose of installing and maintaining outdoor seating and food service in the public right-of-
21 way of Front Street adjacent to the permittee's property at 2202 Front Street (Parcel No. 02-
22 14274). The permit shall be substantially in the form now on file with the Clerk in Council
23 File No. ___ and shall contain such terms and conditions as are necessary in the opinion of
24 the Director of Law to protect the public interest.



26 Section 2. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
27 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions
28 or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not
29 previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

31 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
32 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this
33 Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted
34 in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal
35 requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.



37 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
38 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
39 Cuyahoga Falls, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members
40 elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
41 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the
42 earliest period allowed by law.
