7 ORDINANCE NO. 57 - 2011

8  
9 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC  
10 CONTROL FILE BY PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION  
11 OF VARIOUS TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, AND  
12 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13  
14 WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established  
15 and maintained in the "Traffic Control File," a document established and  
16 maintained by the Chief of Police pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified  
17 Ordinances, and

18  
19 WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the  
20 Traffic Control File be made only through legislation passed by City Council,

21  
22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of  
23 Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

24  
25 Section 1. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the  
26 Traffic Control File is hereby amended as follows:

- 27  
28 (1) To prohibit parking on the north side of Woodridge Drive and to  
29 continue the current parking prohibition on the south side of  
30 Woodridge Drive from 8:00am - 4:00pm during school days.  
31 (2) To prohibit parking on the even side of 15th Street from 2546 15<sup>th</sup>  
32 Street to 2528 15<sup>th</sup> Street, inclusive, from 7:00am - 4:00pm Monday  
33 through Friday.  
34 (3) To prohibit parking on Hudson Drive from the driveway serving 2884  
35 Hudson Drive to Grove Avenue.  
36 (4) To prohibit parking on the east side of 20th Street from Chestnut  
37 Blvd. to Sackett Avenue between the hours of 7:00pm - 7:00am.

38  
39 Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to note  
40 in the Traffic Control File the proper legends.

41  
42 Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the  
43 installation or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.

44  
45 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of  
46 ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any  
47 ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not  
48 inconsistent herewith and which have not been previously repealed are hereby  
49 ratified and confirmed.

50  
51 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this  
52 Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted

53 in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and  
54 of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings  
55 open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter  
56 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

57  
58 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency  
59 measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety,  
60 convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants  
61 thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
62 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force  
63 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall  
64 take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
