7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO  
8 AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT KNOWN AS THE  
9 SUMMIT COUNTY INTERGOVERNMENTAL MEMORANDUM OF  
10 UNDERSTANDING FOR JOB CREATION AND RETENTION AND  
11 TAX REVENUE SHARING, AS AMENDED, AND DECLARING AN  
12 EMERGENCY.

14 WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of Ord. No. 74-2010, the City and 14 other local gov-  
15 ernments entered into the Summit County Intergovernmental Memorandum of Understanding for  
16 Job Creation and Retention and Tax Revenue Sharing, and

17  
18 WHEREAS, certain amendments have been proposed to the agreement,

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County  
21 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:



23 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into the Summit County Intergovern-  
24 mental Memorandum of Understanding for Job Creation and Retention and Tax Revenue Sharing,  
25 as amended, substantially in the form of agreement placed on file with the Clerk of Council.



27 Section 2. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
28 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordi-  
29 nances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed  
30 are hereby ratified and confirmed.

31  
32 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
33 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and  
34 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal  
35 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including  
36 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.



38 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
39 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
40 Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
41 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
42 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest  
43 period allowed by law.
