8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
9 CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING
10 WITH MOTOROLA, INC. FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE PUBLIC
11 SAFETY REGIONAL DISPATCH SYSTEM EQUIPMENT, AND
12 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

14 WHEREAS, Motorola, Inc. is the sole source purveyor of maintenance and repair services for
15 Motorola radio equipment;
16

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
18 Summit and State of Ohio, that:
19

20 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts without
21 competitive bidding with Motorola, Inc., on the basis of its proposal dated December 21, 2010, for the
22 maintenance and repair of the City's Motorola-manufactured Public Safety Regional Dispatch System
23 equipment.

25 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same
26 from General Fund, Communications Department, line item Other Operations.


28 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
29 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or
30 portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
31 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

33 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
34 relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all
35 deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in
36 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the
37 Codified Ordinances.


39 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
40 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
41 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
42 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
43 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period
44 allowed by law.
