7 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SUPPLEMENTAL
8 APPROPRIATIONS OF MONEY FOR CAPITAL EXPENDITURES
9 OF THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS FROM THE COMMUNITY
10 DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUND, AND DECLARING AN
11 EMERGENCY.

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13 WHEREAS, Article VI, Sections 7 and 8 of the City Charter provide that City Council may
14 revise, amend, and supplement budgetary appropriations during the fiscal year, and may
15 authorize the transfer of unencumbered appropriations within various accounts,

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17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
18 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

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20 Section 1. In order to provide moneys to pay capital expenditures during fiscal year 2012,
21 moneys are hereby appropriated from the un-appropriated fund balances of the departments or
22 divisions as set forth as follows:

CDBG	Community Development	Capital Outlays	\$292,933.00


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25 Section 2. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
26 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of
27 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
28 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

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30 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
31 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
32 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
33 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
34 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.


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36 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
37 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
38 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
39 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
40 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
41 period allowed by law.
