AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH COMMERCIAL FITNESS SOLUTIONS, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF FITNESS EQUIPMENT FOR THE NATATORIUM RECREATION AND WELLNESS CENTER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Precor exercise and fitness equipment installed at the Natatorium Recreation and Wellness Center is a unique and non-fungible product serving as an integral part of the Center; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Board seeks to expand its existing array of Precor exercise equipment at the Center; and

WHEREAS, Commercial Fitness Solutions, Inc. is the sole source purveyor of Precor exercise and fitness equipment in this region,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Parks and Recreation Board is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract or contracts without competitive bidding with Commercial Fitness Solutions, Inc., on the basis of its proposal dated September 2, 2011, for the purchase of ten (10) PreCor treadmills model 833 with 5 year warranty, nine (9) PreCor elliptical riders model EFX 835, seven (7) PreCor elliptical riders model EFX 833, said purchase to include trade-in of ten (10) treadmills and twelve (12) elliptical riders, and associated service agreements, for the Natatorium Recreation and Wellness Center.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Finance Director is authorized and directed to make payment for same from the Leisure Time Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

<u>Section 3.</u> Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings

open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances. Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
