7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SAFETY TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS
9 WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH FINLEY FIRE
10 EQUIPMENT COMPANY, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF A
11 "HURST JAWS OF LIFE" BRAND HYDRAULIC RESCUE TOOL
12 SET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
13

14 WHEREAS, Finley Fire Equipment Company, Inc. is the sole source purveyor of "Hurst Jaws
15 of Life" brand hydraulic rescue tool sets in this region;
16

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
18 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:
19

20 Section 1. The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
21 contracts without competitive bidding with Finley Fire Equipment Company, Inc., on the basis of
22 its proposal dated September 4, 2012, for the purchase of a "Hurst Jaws of Life" brand hydraulic
23 rescue tool set.

25 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for
26 same from the Capital Projects Fund.
27

28 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
29 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
30 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
31

32 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
33 relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that
34 all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were
35 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107
36 of the Codified Ordinances.
37

38 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
39 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
40 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
41 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
42 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
43 period allowed by law.
