ordinance no. 91 -2012

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AND/OR CONTRACTS WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH KARVO PAVING COMPANY FOR EMERGENCY PAVEMENT REPAIRS TO A PORTION OF GRAHAM ROAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on September 7, 2012, two adjacent water mains in Graham Road failed at a point abutting 180 Graham Road, requiring immediate excavation and repair; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §735.051 authorizes this Council to waive formal competitive bidding and advertising for contracts where there is a real and present emergency arising in connection with the operation and maintenance of a municipally-owned utility; and

WHEREAS, there exists a real and present emergency in connection with damage to the pavement of Graham Road between 144 and 180 Graham Road, due to the aforementioned water main failures, such that normal competitive bidding for the pavement repair contract cannot be accomplished without unreasonable risk to public safety,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract and/or contracts without competitive bidding with Karvo Paving Company for emergency repair to approximately 400 linear feet of the pavement of Graham Road, from 144 to 180 Graham Road, as a result of water main failures on September 7, 2012.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is authorized to make payment for same from the Water Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the

public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to permit timely and appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
