7 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
8 PUBLIC SERVICE TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT
9 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE FORM OF A GRANT
10 OR LOAN FROM THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS
11 COMMISSION FOR REPLACEMENT OF A 16" WATER
12 MAIN IN GRAHAM ROAD, AND DECLARING AN
13 EMERGENCY.
14

15 WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC), through its State
16 Capital Improvement Program and Local Transportation Improvement Program,
17 provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to
18 public infrastructure; and
19

20 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls has identified the need, plans for, and
21 proposes a capital improvement to public infrastructure, to wit: replacement of a
22 16" water main, including all necessary appurtenances, in Graham Road between
23 Bath Road and Graham Road Circle; and

25 WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement hereinabove described is considered
26 to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC
27 programs,
28

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga
30 Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio:
31

32 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to apply for and
33 accept financial assistance in the form of a grant or loan from the Ohio Public
34 Works Commission for the purpose of supporting the capital improvement
35 consisting of replacement of a 16" water main, including all necessary
36 appurtenances, in Graham Road between Bath Road and Graham Road Circle, by
37 means of the State Capital Improvement Program (SCIP) and/or Local
38 Transportation Improvement Program (LTIP) administered by the Ohio Public
39 Works Commission.
40

41 Section 2. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into
42 agreements as may be necessary to apply for and accept the financial assistance
43 mentioned herein.
44

45 Section 3. The Clerk is hereby directed to prepare and transmit a certified copy
46 of this Resolution to the Ohio Public Works Commission.
47

48 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
49 concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open

50 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
51 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the
52 public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable,
53 including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
54

55 Section 5. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
56 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and
57 welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it
58 received the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to
59 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and
60 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
61 period allowed by law.
