RESOLUTION NO. 35 -2012

A RESOLUTION MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS RELATIVE TO THE TRANSFER OF A TYPE D-2 CM LIQUOR PERMIT TO RISER FOODS COMPANY dba GIANT EAGLE, 230 HOWE AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Riser Foods Company dba Giant Eagle is seeking the transfer of a Type D-1 liquor permit to its location at 230 Howe Avenue, Cuyahoga Falls; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code ("R.C.") prohibits the issuance of certain Dseries liquor permits beyond a maximum specified by a formula contained in R.C. §4303.29(B)(2)(a), unless the transfer is to an economic development project; and

WHEREAS, R.C. §4303.29 specifies that the Superintendent of Liquor Control shall determine whether the proposed recipient of the liquor permit is an economic development project based upon several factors including, but not limited to whether the local municipal corporation acknowledges that the transfer of the liquor permit will be to an economic development project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Council finds and determines that the proposed transfer of a Type D-14 Tiquor permit to Riser Foods Company dba Giant Eagle, at the store located at 230 Howe Avenue, Cuyahoga Falls, is a transfer to an economic development project within the meaning of R.C. §4303.29(B)(2).

Section 2. The Clerk of Council shall provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the Superintendent of Liquor Control.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 4. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it received the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to
