6 RESOLUTION NO. 8 - 2012

8 A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR AND  
9 URGING PASSAGE OF ISSUE 8, THE CUYAHOGA  
10 FALLS CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT TAX LEVY, AT THE  
11 PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MARCH 6,  
12 2012, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

15 WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga Falls City School District has caused a proposed tax  
16 levy to be placed on the March 6, 2012 primary election ballot as Issue 8, and  
17

18 WHEREAS, funds generated by the five-year, 4.75-mill levy are necessary to  
19 help fund the current expenses of the Cuyahoga Falls City School District, and  
20

21 WHEREAS, the proposed levy, if passed, will not increase any taxes, but is a  
22 renewal of an existing levy first passed in 2002, and which was renewed by the  
23 electorate in 2007, and  
24

25 WHEREAS, the passage and renewal of this levy in 2002 and 2007  
26 demonstrates the abiding support that the Cuyahoga Falls City School District has  
27 in the community at large, and  
28

29 WHEREAS, the sustained value and appeal of housing in communities is  
30 directly related to the success of the school districts, and  
31

32 WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga Falls City School District has consistently provided  
33 excellent academic, co-curricular and extracurricular programming for its  
34 students, and  
35

36 WHEREAS, the uncertainty of state funding for public education continues to  
37 place a burden on the district's ability to maintain said programs and services,  
38

39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga  
40 Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:  
41

42 Section 1. This Council expresses its support for the Cuyahoga Falls City School  
43 District and urges the passage of Issue 8 at the March 6, 2012 primary election.  
44

45 Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
46 concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open  
47 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its  
48 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the  
49 public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the  
50 Codified Ordinances.  
51

52 Section 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure  
53 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and

54 welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it  
55 receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to  
56 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and  
57 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest  
58 period allowed by law.
