AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS. ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN MATERIALS, SUPPLIES, EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES FOR USE BY THE ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT DURING 2007, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary during the course of each year to purchase for the Electric Department, certain materials, supplies and services needed by such Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the purchase of the following materials, supplies, equipment and services for use by the Electric Department during 2007:

Transformers Meter Sockets Lamps Wire Underground Material Hardware Substation Battery Rubber Protection Equipment

Watthour Meters **Instrument Transformers** Luminaries Line Material Switches Surge Arresters/Fault Indicators

**Breaker Contacts** Cable Handler

That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from the Electric Department Fund, line items Other Operations and Capital.

That any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
