7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN
10 MATERIALS, SUPPLIES, EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES FOR USE BY
11 THE ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT DURING 2007, AND DECLARING AN
12 EMERGENCY.

14 WHEREAS, it is necessary during the course of each year to purchase for the Electric Department,
15 certain materials, supplies and services needed by such Department;

16
17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
18 Summit and State of Ohio:

20 Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
21 contracts, according to law, for the purchase of the following materials, supplies, equipment and
22 services for use by the Electric Department during 2007:


33 Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for
34 same from the Electric Department Fund, line items Other Operations and Capital.

36 Section 3. That any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
37 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not
38 inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

40 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
41 relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all
42 deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in
43 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the
44 Codified Ordinances.



46 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
47 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls
48 and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members
49 elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and
50 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by
51 law.


