WHEREAS, Section 2 of the City Charter, adopted pursuant to Art. XVIII, Sections 3 and 7 of the Ohio Constitution, authorizes this Council to make exception to the competitive bidding procedures set forth in the Revised Code,

Notwithstanding and as an exception to the competitive bidding requirements set forth in Title 7 and elsewhere in the Ohio Revised Code, the Director of Public Service is authorized to enter into a contract with the North Central Service Cooperative dba National Joint Powers Alliance ("NJPA"), a political subdivision of the State of Minnesota, for the purpose of establishing membership in NJPA, and for the further purpose of purchasing products, services, materials and supplies through cooperative purchase agreements administered by NJPA. Competitive bidding requirements which would otherwise be associated with such purchases are hereby waived.

Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
