7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A THIRD MODIFICATION OF
9 CONTRACT NO. 7045 WITH CT CONSULTANTS, AND
10 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

12 WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of Ord. No. 64-2014, the Director of Public Service
13 entered into Contract No. 7045, with CT Consultants, for the professional design
14 engineering services necessary to proceed with improvements to Howe Avenue from Main
15 Street to Buchholzer Boulevard (the "Project"); and

16
17 WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of Section 181.06 of the Codified Ordinances, the
18 City entered into a first modification of said contract on or about April 25, 2016; and

19
20 WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of Section 181.06 of the Codified Ordinances, the
21 City entered into a second modification of said contract on or about December 27, 2016;
22 and

24 WHEREAS, for the project to proceed, an additional plan submittal was required to
25 satisfy the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), and a stakeholder meeting is
26 requested by ODOT in 2018.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
29 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

30
31 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a third
32 modification of Contract No. 7045, with CT Consultants, on the basis of its proposal dated
33 November 10, 2017, in an amount not to exceed \$49,375.00. The total contract price after
34 modification as authorized herein shall not exceed \$692,125.00.

35
36 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment
37 for same from the Capital Projects Fund, line Capital Outlay.

39 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
40 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions
41 or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not
42 previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

44 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
45 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this
46 Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted
47 in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal
48 requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.


