9 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
10 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS FOR  
11 THE PURCHASE OF PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR  
12 SERVICES RELATED TO SPECIALIZED VEHICLES AND  
13 EQUIPMENT USED BY THE SANITATION DEPARTMENT, AND  
14 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

17 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State  
18 of Ohio, that:

19  
20 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contact or  
21 contracts, according to law, for preventive maintenance and repair services related to specialized  
22 vehicles and equipment used by the Sanitation Department.  
23

24 Section 2. The Finance Director is authorized and directed to make payment for same from  
25 the Sanitation Fund, Line Item Other Operations.  
26

27 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
28 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of  
29 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been  
30 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.  
31

32 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
33 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and  
34 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal  
35 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including  
36 Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.  
37

38 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
39 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
40 Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
41 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
42 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest  
43 period allowed by law.
