7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
8 PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR
9 CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE
10 PURCHASE OF ANNUAL REQUIREMENTS OF
11 CERTAIN MATERIALS, SUPPLIES AND SERVICES
12 FOR USE BY THE GARAGE DIVISION DURING 2016,
13 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

14
15 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
16 Summit and State of Ohio, that:

17
18 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into
19 a contract or contracts, according to law, for the purchase of certain materials,
20 supplies and services for use by the Garage Division during 2016:

- 21
- 22 Fuel
- 23 Tires
- 24 Repairs
- 25 Parts
- 26

27 Notwithstanding and as an exception to Section 181.06 of the Codified
28 Ordinances, expenditures made under the contracts authorized by this
29 ordinance shall not exceed in the aggregate, \$1,209,500, without further
30 consent of City Council by ordinance or resolution.

31
32 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to
33 make payment for same from the Garage Fund, line item Other Operations.

34
35 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances
36 and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances
37 and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
38 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and
39 confirmed.

41 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
42 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an
43 open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of
44 any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open
45 to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107
46 of the Codified Ordinances.

47
48 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
49 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience
50 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof for the
51 reason that the supplies are necessary for the daily functioning of the Municipal
52 Garage, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the

53 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
54 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall
55 take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
