CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS, OHIO  
ORDINANCE NO 108 - 2017

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE CITY'S REQUIREMENTS OF CERTAIN SERVICES, MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES FOR USE BY THE WATER AND SEWER DIVISION DURING 2018, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the purchase of the City's requirements for the following services, materials and supplies for use by the Water and Sewer Division during 2018:

- Water Treatment Chemicals
- Utility Patch Program
- Meters and Related Materials
- Miscellaneous Equipment, Repairs, and Repair Parts
- Waterline and Sewer Line Supplies
- Fire hydrants and Related Materials

Notwithstanding and as an exception to Section 181.06 of the Codified Ordinances, expenditures made under the contracts authorized by this ordinance shall not exceed, in the aggregate, \$716,500, without further consent of City Council by ordinance or resolution.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from the Water Fund and Sewer Fund, line item Other Operations.

Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open

49 to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107  
50 of the Codified Ordinances.

52 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure  
53 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience  
54 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and  
55 provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or  
56 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
57 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force  
58 at the earliest period allowed by law.
