25 services necessary to conduct the administration of the City's self-insured employee  
26 medical and prescription drug plans, and for stop-loss insurance coverage related to  
27 said plans, for a period not to exceed three years.  
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29 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to pay approved invoices  
30 for work based upon the Contract, from the Self-Insurance Fund, line item Other  
31 Operations.  
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33 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
34 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and  
35 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed  
36 are hereby ratified and confirmed.  
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38 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
39 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open  
40 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its  
41 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public,  
42 in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter  
43 107 of the Codified Ordinances.  
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45 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure  
46 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and  
47 welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of  
48 two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be

49 in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall  
50 take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
