3 ORDINANCE NO. // - 2007

5 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE  
6 TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, ACCORDING  
7 TO LAW, TO UPGRADE THE CITY'S COMPUTER NETWORK  
8 INFRASTRUCTURE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

11  
12 WHEREAS, the computer network infrastructure is an essential part of the City's daily  
13 operations; and

14  
15 WHEREAS, the existing equipment is no longer maintainable because of age;

16  
17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County  
18 of Summit and State of Ohio:

19  
20 Section 1. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts,  
21 according to law, for the purpose of upgrading the City's computer network infrastructure.



23 Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for  
24 same from the Capital Projects Fund.

26 Section 3. That any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
27 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and  
28 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have  
29 not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

30  
31 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning  
32 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council  
33 and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal  
34 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including  
35 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

37 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for  
38 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of  
39 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of  
40 two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force  
41 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in  
42 force at the earliest period allowed by law.
