5 ORDINANCE NO. 111 - 2015

7 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CUYAHOGA FALLS  
8 PARTNERSHIP FOR PARKS DONATION FUND, AND DECLARING  
9 AN EMERGENCY.

10  
11 WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish an agency fund to record the deposit of donations  
12 collected on behalf of the Cuyahoga Falls Partnership for Parks organization, and remittance of  
13 those deposits to the same organization.

14  
15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County  
16 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

17  
18 Section 1. There is hereby created a Cuyahoga Falls Partnership for Parks Donation Fund.

19  
20 Section 2. Funds in the Cuyahoga Falls Partnership for Parks Donation Fund are the  
21 deposit of donations collected at City facilities on behalf of the Cuyahoga Falls Partnership for  
22 Parks organization, and remittance of those deposits to the same organization.

23  
24 Section 3. The Parks and Recreation Board, as the appointing authority, is authorized to  
25 execute all necessary documentation for receipt of such funds.

26  
27 Section 4. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
28 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent  
29 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

30  
31 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
32 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and  
33 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal  
34 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including, to  
35 the extent applicable, Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

36  
37 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
38 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
39 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
40 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
41 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest  
42 period allowed by law.
