ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CUYAHOGA FALLS PARTNERSHIP FOR PARKS DONATION FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish an agency fund to record the deposit of donations collected on behalf of the Cuyahoga Falls Partnership for Parks organization, and remittance of those deposits to the same organization.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. There is hereby created a Cuyahoga Falls Partnership for Parks Donation Fund.

<u>Sections 2.</u> Funds in the Cuyahoga Falls Partnership for Parks Donation Fund are the deposit of donations collected at City facilities on behalf of the Cuyahoga Falls Partnership for Parks organization, and remittance of those deposits to the same organization.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Parks and Recreation Board, as the appointing authority, is authorized to execute all necessary documentation for receipt of such funds.

<u>Section 4.</u> Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including, to the extent applicable, Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 6.</u> This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
