6 ORDINANCE NO. 112 - 2017

8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
9 PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT
10 WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH
11 GREENSTAR MID-AMERICA, LLC FOR THE
12 TRANSFER, PROCESSING AND SALE OF
13 RECYCLABLE MATERIALS ACQUIRED BY THE CITY
14 THROUGH ITS CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROGRAM,
15 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
16

17 WHEREAS, the City's Department of Public Service, Division of Sanitation
18 requested proposals for recycling processing services and received two
19 proposals for review; and
20

21 WHEREAS, Greenstar Mid-America, LLC's proposal dated November 30,
22 2017 was the lowest and best proposal for recycle processing services.
23

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of
25 Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:
26

27 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into
28 a contract without competitive bidding with Greenstar Mid-America, LLC, on
29 the basis of its proposal dated November 30, 2017 for the transfer, processing
30 and sale of recyclable materials acquired by the City through its curbside
31 recycling program, for an initial three (3) year period with an option to renew for
32 additional one (1) year terms with the mutual consent of the parties.
33

34 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to
35 make payment for same from Sanitation Fund, line item Other Operations.
36

37 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
38 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
39 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
40 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
41

42 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
43 concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open
44 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any
45 committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the
46 public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the
47 Codified Ordinances.

49 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
50 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience


51 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and
52 provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
53 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
54 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force
55 at the earliest period allowed by law.


