6 ORDINANCE NO. 118 - 2017

8 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC
9 CONTROL FILE BY PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION
10 OF VARIOUS TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, AND
11 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established
14 and maintained in the "Traffic Control File," a document established and
15 maintained by the Chief of Police pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified
16 Ordinances, and

17
18 WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the
19 Traffic Control File be made only through legislation passed by City Council.

20
21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of
22 Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

23
24 Section 1. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic
25 Control File is hereby amended as follows:

- 26
27 1. Prohibit parking on the even sides of the following streets:
28 Salt Creek Run
29 South Creek Drive
30 Pebble Creek Court
31 Prohibit parking on the odd side of the following streets:
32 Preserve Circle
33 Lakeside Oval
34 2. Prohibit parking on the odd side of Salt Creek Run between State
35 Road and Preserve Circle.
36 3. Prohibit parking within 80' of any intersection in Salt Creek
37 Allotment.
38 4. Change the no parking bus stop signs on Falls Avenue between 2nd
39 Street and 3rd Street from no parking from 7-9 AM and 2-4 PM to no
40 parking 2-4 PM.

42 Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to note in
43 the Traffic Control File the proper legends.

44
45 Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the
46 installation or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.

47
48 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances
49 and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances
50 and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent

51 herewith and which have not been previously repealed are hereby ratified and
52 confirmed.

53

54 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
55 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an
56 open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of
57 any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open
58 to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107
59 of the Codified Ordinances.

61 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
62 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience
63 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and
64 provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
65 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
66 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force
67 at the earliest period allowed by law.


