7 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PAY RANGES FOR PART-TIME,
8 PER DIEM, AND SPECIAL CLASSIFICATION WORKERS, AND
9 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
12 of Summit and State of Ohio:



14 Section 1. That pay ranges are hereby established for part-time, per diem, and special
15 classification workers as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

17 Section 2. That any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
18 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not
19 inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and
20 confirmed.

22 Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
23 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council
24 and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
25 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
26 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

28 Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
29 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
30 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of
31 two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
32 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in
33 force at the earliest period allowed by law.
