7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
8 FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE PURCHASE OF
10 HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE ASSOCIATED WITH THE
11 UPGRADE OF THE CITY'S PERSONAL COMPUTERS, AND
12 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

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14 WHEREAS, this purchase will replace outdated Personal Computers in various
15 departments, and

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17 WHEREAS, The upgrade is necessary to remove outdated operating software that is
18 no longer supported by Microsoft, and

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20 WHEREAS, Vendors will be on state contract and therefore bids will not be
21 obtained.

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23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
24 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

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26 Section 1. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
27 contracts, according to law, for the purchase of hardware and software associated with
28 the upgrade of the City's personal computers through a state bid or any other source
29 having a price equal to or lower than that provided by the state bid. Any requirement for
30 competitive bidding is hereby suspended.

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32 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make
33 payment for same from the Capital Projects, Sewer, Water, Electric, Sanitation, Leisure
34 Time, Storm Drainage Utility, Garage and Utility Billing Funds, line item Capital Outlay.
35 Furthermore, the Director of Finance is authorized to amend appropriations as follows:

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39 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
40 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and

41 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and
42 which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
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44 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
45 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
46 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
47 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in
48 compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified
49 Ordinances.
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51 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
52 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and
53 welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof for the reason that the
54 supplies are necessary for the daily functioning of the Street Department, and provided
55 it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to
56 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval
57 by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed
58 by law.
