ORDINANCE NO. - 2014

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS. ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE PURCHASE OF HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE ASSOCIATED WITH THE UPGRADE OF THE CITY'S PERSONAL COMPUTERS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this purchase will replace outdated Personal Computers in various departments, and

WHEREAS, The upgrade is necessary to remove outdated operating software that is no longer supported by Microsoft, and

WHEREAS, Vendors will be on state contract and therefore bids will not be obtained.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the purchase of hardware and software associated with the upgrade of the City's personal computers through a state bid or any other source having a price equal to or lower than that provided by the state bid. Any requirement for competitive bidding is hereby suspended.

The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from the Capital Projects, Sewer, Water, Electric, Sanitation, Leisure Time, Storm Drainage Utility, Garage and Utility Billing Funds, line item Capital Outlay. Furthermore, the Director of Finance is authorized to amend appropriations as follows:

Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and

resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

<u>Section 5</u>. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof for the reason that the supplies are necessary for the daily functioning of the Street Department, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
