7 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF THE CODIFIED
8 ORDINANCES TO CONFORM TO STATE LAW, APPROVING THE 2015
9 REPLACEMENT PAGES TO THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY
10 OF CUYAHOGA FALLS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

12 WHEREAS, Article XVIII, Section 3 of the Ohio Constitution provides that municipalities shall have
13 the authority to enforce local police, sanitary and other similar regulations as are not in conflict with
14 general laws, and

15
16 WHEREAS, certain provisions within the Codified Ordinances of the City of Cuyahoga Falls should be
17 amended to conform to current State laws that have been amended, so as to avoid conflict in matters that
18 are not subject to the City's powers of local self-government; and

19
20 WHEREAS, various ordinances and ordinance amendments of a general and permanent nature have
21 been passed by this Council which should be included in the published Codified Ordinances; and

23 WHEREAS, the City has heretofore entered into a contract with the Walter H. Drane Company to
24 prepare and publish such revisions as are approved by this Council,

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
27 Summit and State of Ohio, that:

29 Section 1. The Ordinances of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio, of a general and permanent nature,
30 as revised, recodified, rearranged and consolidated into component codes, titles, chapters and sections
31 within the 2015 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances, are hereby approved and adopted.

33 Section 2. The following sections and chapters are hereby added, amended or repealed as
34 respectively indicated in order to comply with current State law.

60 Section 3. The complete text of the sections listed above are set forth in full in the current
61 replacement pages to the Codified Ordinances which are hereby attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A.
62 The listing above of each new section by reference to its title shall constitute sufficient publication of new
63 matter contained therein.

65 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
66 to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all
67 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in
68 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the
69 Codified Ordinances.

71 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
72 preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and its inhabitants for the reason
73 that there exists an imperative necessity for the earliest publication and distribution of current
74 Replacement Pages to the officials and residents of the Municipality, so as to facilitate administration,
75 daily operation and avoid practical and legal entanglements, and provided that it receives the affirmative
76 vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
77 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at
78 the earliest period allowed by law.
