9 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARKS AND RECREATION
10 BOARD TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
11 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE
12 RESTROOM BUILDING IN WATER WORKS PARK, AND
13 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

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15 WHEREAS, the restroom building in Water Works Park was built 55 years ago in 1962 and
16 has surpassed its useful life; and

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18 WHEREAS, a new six station restroom that meets all required codes will better serve the
19 community.

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
22 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

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24 Section 1. The Parks and Recreation Board is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
25 contracts, according to law, for the replacement of the restroom building in Water Works Park.

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28 Section 2. The Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same
29 from the Recreation Levy Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

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31 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
32 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of
33 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
34 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

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36 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
37 relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
38 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
39 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
40 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

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42 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
43 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
44 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
45 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
46 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
47 period allowed by law.
