7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE
8 TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS FOR THE
9 LEASE AND/OR PURCHASE OF FITNESS EQUIPMENT FOR
10 THE NATATORIUM RECREATION AND WELLNESS CENTER
11 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 WHEREAS, the exercise and fitness equipment is an integral part of the Natatorium
14 Recreation and Wellness Center

15
16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
17 of Summit and State of Ohio:
18

19 Section 1. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
20 contracts for the lease and/or purchase of fitness equipment for the Natatorium Recreation and
21 Wellness Center.


23 Section 2. That the Director of Finance is authorized to make payment for same from the
24 Leisure Time Fund, line item Capital Outlay. The Director of Finance is further authorized to
25 increase appropriations in said fund and line item by \$20,000.

27 Section 3. That any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
28 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
29 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have
30 not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
31

32 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
33 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council
34 and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
35 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
36 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
37

38 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
39 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
40 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of
41 two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
42 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in
43 force at the earliest period allowed by law.
