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18 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and

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21 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
22 contracts, according to law, for the repair and resurfacing of Tallmadge Road from Newberry
23 Street to a point 300' south of Clyde Avenue, in the City of Cuyahoga Falls.
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
25 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment
26 for same from the Capital Projects Fund.
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28 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
29 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not
30 inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and
31 confirmed.
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33 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
34 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this
35 Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted
36 in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal
37 requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
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
39 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
40 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
41 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary
42 to permit timely and appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the
43 affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take
44 effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it
45 shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
