17 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

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19 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts,
20 according to law, for concrete and masonry repairs to the City-owned parking garages located at 2035 Old
21 Town Loop (the "Blue" Parking Deck), 2052 Front Street (the "Red" Parking Deck), and 2318 Second Street
22 (the "Green" Parking Deck).
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24 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from the
25 Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.
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27 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent
28 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have
29 not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
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31 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the
32 adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this
33 Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public,
34 in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified
35 Ordinances.
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37 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation
38 of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants
39 thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to
40 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor;
41 otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
