ORDINANCE NO. // - 2013

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL FILE BY PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION OF VARIOUS TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established and maintained in the "Traffic Control File," a document established and maintained by the Chief of Police pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified Ordinances, and

WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the Traffic Control File be made only through legislation passed by City Council,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control File is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. To prohibit parking on both sides of Marcia Blvd. between State Road and 23rd Street.
- 2. To prohibit parking on the south side of Shaw Avenue between State Road and 23rd Street.
- 3. To require stop signs both eastbound and westbound on Graham Road Circle at its intersection with an unnamed connector road that connects Graham Road and Graham Road Circle adjacent to 1050 Graham Road.
- 4. To prohibit parking on the north side (odd-numbered addresses) of Quartz Avenue from its easterly intersection with Boulder Blvd. to a point 75 feet northwest.
- 5. To prohibit parking on the north side (odd-numbered addresses) of Boulder Blvd. from its easterly intersection with Quartz Ave. to a point 60 feet east.
- 6. To remove the stop sign controlling southbound traffic on 26th Street turning right at Sackett Avenue, and install a yield sign.
- 7. To remove the stop sign controlling eastbound traffic on Broad Blvd. at 26th Street, and install a yield sign.

Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to note in the Traffic Control File the proper legends.

<u>Section 3</u>. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the installation or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.

<u>Section 4</u>. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not been previously repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
