7 ORDINANCE NO. 18 - 2016

9 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARKS AND RECREATION  
10 BOARD TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,  
11 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE REPAIR OF THE NATATORIUM  
12 ROOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13  
14 WHEREAS, the roof above the gymnasium and fitness floor in the Natatorium are leaking.

15  
16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County  
17 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

18  
19 Section 1. The Parks and Recreation Board is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or  
20 contracts, according to law, for the repair of the Natatorium roof.

23 Section 2. The Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same  
24 from the Leisure Time Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

25  
26 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
27 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of  
28 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been  
29 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

30  
31 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
32 relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and  
33 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal  
34 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including  
35 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

36  
37 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
38 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
39 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
40 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
41 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest  
42 period allowed by law.
